SUBJECT: PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE 2009-2012 TRANSPORTATION

IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR SOUTHEASTERN WISCONSIN

Two proposed amendments to the 2009-2012 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for Southeastern Wisconsin are provided in Exhibit A to this memorandum. These two amendments as proposed would utilize a combined total of \$91 million in Interstate Highway – Completion or Substitution Funds allocated to the Milwaukee Urbanized Area to implement a segment of the City of Milwaukee's Downtown Connector Streetcar and capital expenditures associated with Milwaukee County's East-West Bus Rapid Transit Line.

These two proposed amendments may not be expected to affect the implementation schedule of other projects currently programmed in the TIP, and the entire TIP as amended may be expected to remain consistent with projected available funding. Both amendments are exempt from the requirement to conduct an air quality conformity, or regional emissions, analysis with respect to the State of Wisconsin Air Quality Implementation Plan, as the projects either entail the purchase of new buses or represent a minor expansion of the fleet.

A return postcard is enclosed on which we ask that you indicate your approval or disapproval of these proposed amendments to the TIP. Please review the proposed amendments, and indicate your approval or disapproval no later than July 22, 2009.

The regional plan identifies the streetcar project as a potential express transit guideway improvement, and calls for the planning study underway to be completed and a locally preferred alternative be identified.
