Notice to Public: Title VI Compliance

The Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission hereby gives public notice of its policy to uphold and assure full compliance with Title VI of Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987, Executive Order 12898 on Environmental Justice, and related statutes and regulations in all programs and activities. Title VI requires that no person in the United States of America shall, on the grounds of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from the participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity for which the Commission receives Federal financial assistance.

Any person who believes that they have been aggrieved by an unlawful discriminatory practice under Title VI has a right to file a formal complaint with the Commission. Any such complaint should be in writing and submitted to Elizabeth A. Larsen, Title VI Coordinator within one hundred eighty (180) days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence.
