WHEREAS, the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission, by Resolution No. 2014-24 on the 13th day of November 2014, endorsed the *Transportation Improvement Program for Southeastern Wisconsin: 2015-2018*; and

WHEREAS, the projects described in Exhibit A have been reviewed and are endorsed by the Advisory Committee on Transportation System Planning and Programming for the Milwaukee Urbanized Area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED:

<u>FIRST:</u> That the projects and budget amounts endorsed by the Advisory Committee on Transportation System Planning and Programming for the Milwaukee Urbanized Area identified in Exhibit A attached hereto hereby are endorsed as amendments to the *Transportation Improvement Program for Southeastern Wisconsin: 2015-2018*.

<u>SECOND</u>: That a true, correct, and exact copy of this resolution and its attachments shall be forthwith transmitted through the Secretary of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation to the Governor, the Federal Transit Administration, and the Federal Highway Administration.
