- Employers can choose any or all of the EAH benefits below:
 - Free home-buying "educational" workshops to employees offered by REALTORS® and lenders
 - One-on-one housing counseling seminars in partnership with a nonprofit counseling agency
 - Financial incentives such as a forgivable loan, matched savings or gifts to help employees purchase a home
