How to Ride





Apply at flexridemke.com. If you're approved, you'll receive an email with an access code. Download the FlexRide Milwaukee app from the App Store or Google Play Store. Follow the sign up steps, then enter your access code in the "Promo Codes" section of the app. Enter your pickup and dropoff locations, then choose the ride that works best for you. Be sure to tap the Wheelchair icon if you need an accessible vehicle! Check the app to find out exactly where to meet the vehicle, which may be a short walk from the location you gave us.
