SUBJECT: PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE 2009-2012 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR SOUTHEASTERN WISCONSIN

One proposed amendment to the 2009-2012 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for Southeastern Wisconsin is provided in Exhibit A to this memorandum. The proposed amendment is being requested by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation. The proposed amendment would revise a project currently in the TIP.

The proposed amendments may not be expected to affect the implementation schedule of other projects currently programmed in the TIP, and the entire TIP as amended may be expected to remain consistent with projected available funding. The amendment is exempt from the requirement to conduct an air quality conformity, or regional emissions, analysis with respect to the State of Wisconsin Air Quality Implementation Plan, as the project entails highway safety.
